



The aim of the contract is to help each child benefit as much as possible from his/her education at Grantham Additional Needs Fellowship. It is designed to encourage a very close working relationship between parents/carers and staff of the school. It also shows how each child has an important part to play in taking full advantage of all the opportunities at school.

The contract is sent out to each pupil and a copy is shown below.

The staff at Grantham Additional Needs Fellowship will:

- Do everything they possibly can to care for your child's well-being and safety while at school
- Treat your child as a valued member of the school community
- Give all pupils the opportunity to achieve their full potential
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum to meet your child's individual needs
- Help and encourage your child to achieve the highest possible standards of work and behaviour
- Provide pupils where appropriate with homework suitable to their needs
- Help pupils develop good relationships and a strong sense of personal values and responsibility
- Listen carefully to pupils to try and sort out any problems within school
- Send you regular assessments of your child's progress
- Give you the opportunity to discuss your child's work at open days, parent mails, website and annual reviews.
- Keep you informed about school activities through regular newsletters

As a parent/carer of a pupil at Grantham Additional Needs Fellowship I will:

- Be aware and accept that the school's policy is the use of a behaviour management system called "Team Teach" which can occasionally include the use of the positive handling of pupils, to ensure their own and others safety and welfare
- Support the school's behaviour policy by agreeing to after school detentions if they are given, and where possible collect my child. (If necessary pupils would be returned home by school transport)



- Do everything I can to support the school in its work with my child
- See that my child attends school regularly
- Make sure that my child gets to school on time and with the proper equipment
- Tell the school about any concerns or problems which may affect my child's work or behaviour
- Support the staff of the school in their work on good behaviour
- Help or support my child with homework where appropriate
- Look for opportunities for my child to learn at home and outside
- Attend Parents' Consultations to discuss progress made
- Work closely with the Senior Leadership Team and staff to try and sort out any possible problems with my child's work or behaviour at school
- Get to know as much as possible about my child's work and life at Grantham Additional Needs Fellowship

As a pupil at Grantham Additional Needs Fellowship I will do my very best to:

- Treat everyone in school with courtesy and respect
- Follow all school rules
- Attend school regularly and to arrive on time in the morning
- Wear the school uniform and be smart every day
- Get to lessons on time and be ready to work
- Bring all the equipment I need for work in school
- Concentrate on my own work in class
- Let others in class get on with their own work
- Do my homework as well as I can
- Look after the school environment
- Help make the school a safe place for everyone
