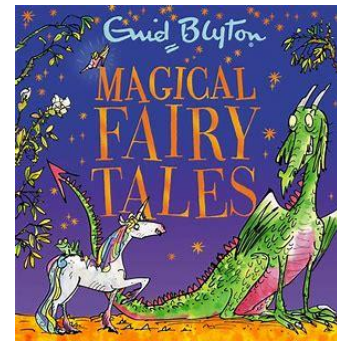

Body parts

To begin to be aware of and find simple body parts e.g. head, tummy, foot, hand.

To begin to be aware of the changes the body goes through.

Physical programmes

Receiving skills

Practice receiving and catching different balls (football, tennis, basketball, table tennis, rugby)

Identify different uses for different size balls.
