



## Curriculum Statement

The “Building Communities of Specialist Provision” scheme. An £86 million investment from the Local Authority across many of the county’s special schools is being used to expand and improve special school provision to ensure the needs of all pupils can be met as close to their homes as possible. The strategy will see Ambergate Sports College and Sandon School amalgamate to become one all needs all through school, operating on three sites by 2025. The start of the hydro-pool build at Sandon School has prompted an early redistribution of pupils between the two schools. As a result, Ambergate Sports College is now providing education to a wider range of learning needs, having previously been specialised in MLD.

The curriculum of the individual schools and the close partnership is acknowledging the forthcoming amalgamation and redistribution of pupils between the two schools. Each school has a clear curriculum intent and implementation with the vision of a one school model. Where required, pupils can move between sites, during their educational journey, to access suitable and challenging curriculum provision. Such decisions are made by school leadership in collaboration with the local authority.
