Upper Key Stage 2

<p>English</p> <p>Fiction Genres: Pupils will explore a wide range of genres, developing a good understanding about the content and purposes. They will then apply their knowledge of different genres to plan and write a variety of stories for set genres.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Four operations: Pupils will understand how addition, subtraction, multiplication and division can be performed with various methods. They will understand how approximation is used in problem solving, and identify factors. Pupils will use known facts from one calculation to determine answers.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Separating materials and their properties: Pupils will learn and explore a variety of separating methods including filtering, dissolving and evaporation and separation of solutes using chromatography. They will predict and test predictions, making observations and checking results.</p>	
<p>RE</p> <p>What can a Humanist teach us? Pupils will understand Humanism is a belief system shared by many people who do not believe in God. They will learn that Humanists care about right behaviour, good values, and the world around them.</p>	<p>Art/DT</p> <p>Be Seen: Pupils will classify materials by fibre sources, they will investigate and develop skills in modifying the appearance of textiles. They will also consider the aesthetic and functional properties of materials. Pupils will create their own item which is visual.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Visual instructions: Pupils will follow visual instructions, and handle and play instruments with control. They will use sounds to illustrate a story, and will use technical terms and everyday words that musicians use. They will explore ternary form and rondo form as a musical structure.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>Ancient Greece: Pupils will learn how and why empires grow and how to explain the chronology of a timeline. They will learn how the political system worked. Pupils will compare different city states and recall facts about the Battle of Marathon. They will learn about Ancient Greek gods and goddesses.</p>
<p>PSHE</p> <p>Every day choices/ Earning and Spending/ Groups I belong to: Pupils will learn how to make and communicate their choices, learn about different ways of earning money, and how it is spent. They will identify a range of groups to which they belong.</p>	<p>Relationship Education</p> <p>My Body: Pupils will learn about the following: What is puberty? What is a 'normal' body? How will my body change as I get older?</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>How do networks work? Pupils will be able to outline the key features of the World Wide Web. They will be able to understand and describe the use of Web 2.0 tools, and explain the difference between a blog and a wiki.</p>	<p>MFL</p> <p>In German pupils will learn numbers 61 - 70. Pupils will also learn expressions.</p>
