Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Wembley Trip – National Justice Museum

On Monday 11th March 2024, Wembley class will be going to the National Justice Museum in Nottingham.

We will be participating in an award-winning anti-knife crime prevention workshop specifically aimed at young people who are unlikely to have considered carrying a knife. The Choices and Consequences Workshop work in partnership with the Ben Kinsella Trust and Nottinghamshire Police, to encourage positive behaviours and attitudes against carrying knives. It measures the ground-breaking prevention approach to combatting knife crime.

The workshop tells the story of Ben Kinsella, who was tragically killed in 2008 aged 16 and is a vehicle to encourage young people to think about the consequences of carrying a knife and the choices they can make to avoid becoming impacted by violence. Through candid videos, local families who have lost loved ones to knife crime open up about the reality of knife crime closer to home to prevent other families from experiencing the same ordeal.

Themes covered through the workshop:

- The dangers of carrying a knife
- The consequences of carrying and associating with those carrying knives
- The law and how it applies to knife crime cases
- The reality of prison life
- Making positive choices to stay safe
- Making safe decisions when it comes to good friends.

Pupils will arrive at school as usual, and we will return to school in time for normal transport home. School uniform is to be worn.

Please could you provide a packed lunch and refreshments for your child. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, please let us know if you would like the school kitchen to provide a packed lunch.
