


# Curriculum Map - Term 4

## Lower Key Stage 2

<b>English</b> Poetry Shape poems/ playing with form: Pupils will be focusing and learning about shape poems, they will explore different structures and the impact they have. Pupils will be focusing on creating their own shape poems based on transport.	<b>Maths</b> Measures: Pupils will measure and compare lines in metres and centimetres. They will use a grid to calculate the perimeter and calculate the perimeter and area of a square or rectangle. Pupils will read, measure and compare a variety of measurements.	<b>Science</b> Plants: Pupils will know a range of plants and how they disperse, they will learn about the importance of roots. They will learn what plants need to sustain growth and focus on how plants can be consumed as food.
<b>RE</b> Why do we wear different clothes on different occasions? Pupils will recognise and name familiar clothes, they will learn that our choice of clothing can depend on many things. They will learn that some people wear clothes relating to their religion.	<b>Art/DT</b> Controllable Vehicles: Pupils will learn how motors, belts and pulleys can be used to control the speed and direction of a vehicle. They will learn how to use a framework to hold all the moving parts needed to control a vehicle and create it.	<b>Music</b> Performing together: Pupils will identify how a mood is created by music and lyrics. Pupils will focus on performing a familiar song, singing different parts. Pupils will learn how to add accompaniments with control and accuracy, using notations as a support.
<b>History</b> Royalty: Pupils will learn how the Normans came to rule Britain in 1066, and why King John is an important king in English history. They will learn about Henry VIII, and understand what the British Empire meant in Victorian Britain. Pupils will learn about the modern royal family.	<b>Computing</b> Control and How to program: Pupils will learn how to add a character to animation software, they will learn how to control the movement, speech, sound and appearance of their sprite. They will learn how to use different control techniques to make an animation.	
<b>PSHE</b> Playing and learning together/Special days: Pupils will focus on recognising certain people and associating them with particular events and share and take turns. They will learn that that bullying is wrong and how to get help.	<b>Relationship Education</b> Keeping safe and looking after myself: Pupils will learn how to respond in uncomfortable situations and what are good/bad secrets.
