Semi-formal Curriculum

<p>English</p> <p>Non-fiction: Pupils will learn what instructions are, they will learn how to order instructions correctly focusing on ordering pictures and writing instructions. Pupils will learn how to review instructions to ensure they are effective. Pupils will learn about the purpose and layout of explanation texts; they will learn why order is important. Pupils will use their knowledge and understanding of explanation text to plan and write their own explanations texts.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Time and money: Pupils will learn to tell the time with the minute and hour hand. They will learn how to recognise coins and notes of money value. Pupils will focus on making amounts of money, they will learn how to add money and find change from an amount.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Recycling and the environment: Pupils will investigate how rubbish is disposed of; they will explore how recycling is important. Pupils will work together to recycle paper waste. Pupils will learn why we should reduce plastic waste, and they will learn how different materials are recycled and the importance of recycling centres.</p>	
<p>RE</p> <p>Festivals: Pupils will learn all about different forms of celebrations. They will learn how Hindu's celebrate the Holi festival, and the importance of Hannukah to the Jewish community. Pupils will learn how Ramadan is celebrated, and they will learn all about the Hindu festival of lights known as Diwali. Pupils will learn the importance of Cinco de Mayo.</p>	<p>Art/DT</p> <p>Masks: Pupils will learn what a mask is, they will learn what the purpose of masks are and how they are used for different occasions. Pupils will focus on designing and creating a variety of masks for set occasions using a variety of resources.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Recycled music: Pupils will learn about a range of instruments, how they are made, how they are played and the sounds in which they produce. Once learning about the instruments, pupils will work together to create their own musical instruments using recyclable materials.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>The local area: Pupils will learn what a compass is and the four main points. Pupils will focus on using positional language to follow directions. Pupils will learn about the local area, and they will work together to explore the local area. Pupils will learn about the different types of housing in our local area, and they will focus on comparing human and physical features.</p>
<p>PSHE</p> <p>Looking after the environment: Pupils will learn what an environment is. They will focus on the environmental benefits of recycling, and how reusing items benefits the environment. Pupils will work together to choose and join a variety of materials to make a sculpture. Pupils will also work together to look after the school environment.</p>	<p>RSE</p> <p>Life cycles: Pupils will learn where babies come from. They will focus on how they have changed since being a baby. Pupils will focus on their own responsibilities now and how they compare to when they were younger.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Online safety: Pupils will learn how the internet can be used to find a range of information. Pupils will learn how to use the internet to answer specific questions, and that not all the information on the internet is true. Pupils will learn how the internet can be used to communicate with people. Pupils will learn how to recognise what needs to happen if they find something inappropriate online.</p>
