<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Poetry - pre 20th century: Pupils will learn the context of a pre 20th Century poem, they will learn key facts about the Romantics and their poems. They will learn to compare two poems by the same author and understand complex language through the use of dictionaries and context.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>Algebra: Pupils will learn how to calculate the terms of a sequence, they will work on continuing a linear sequence, by using addition and subtraction knowledge. Pupils will learn to find the input and output of a function machine of one and two steps. Pupils will form and substitute numbers into an expression.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Matter: Pupils will learn how materials are made up of particles, they will learn how to draw (and describe) diagrams to show the particle arrangement of solids, liquids and gases. Pupils will learn how to use diagrams to represent atoms, molecules and compounds. They will carry out simple separation techniques and how to explain what the periodic table is and describe some of the patterns in it.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>Philosophy and religion: Pupils will learn what the term good means, they will learn how religious and non-religious traditions define goodness. Pupils will learn what sources of authority provide Christians, Muslims and non-religious people with guidance.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">DT</p> <p>Textiles: Pupils will be exploring natural and synthetic materials, textile applications, cultural design (Ghana, UK) and the design and make process to develop a design for a cushion cover.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Music</p> <p>Chords, Ensemble work, Blues: Pupils will use their knowledge of chords, ensemble and blues to help them create a range of performances and musical pieces. They will understand how these techniques impact music.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">History</p> <p>Social, cultural and technological change in post-war British society: Pupils will focus on the changes caused by the end of the British Empire, creation of NHS, changes to society and the impact of technological change on modern British society.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">PSHE</p> <p>Living responsibly: Pupils will focus on behaviours that will support achievement and understand the importance of time management. They will learn emotional literacy and the importance of self-awareness and the meaning of having a growth mind set.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Relationship Sex Education</p> <p>Keeping safe and looking after my sexual health: Pupils will learn about safer sex. They will learn about the impact of drugs and alcohol on health and behaviour. Pupils will learn the importance of being assertive and saying no.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Computing</p> <p>Media: Digital Media: Pupils will learn how to use search terms relating to an issue. They will learn how to use tools to edit an image into another application and how to download an image.
