Curriculum Map - Term 5 Lower Key Stage 2



English

Fiction Adventure stories: Pupils will explore the conventions of adventure stories. They will focus on planning and structuring their own story, understanding the use of first and third person narratives.

Maths

Time and money: Pupils will learn how to convert money into pounds and pence. Pupils will solve real-life problems that involve money and give change from an amount. They will learn to use the language 'past' and 'to' to tell the time. They will learn to find the start and end time of an activity and compare duration.

Science

States of matter: Pupils will learn that materials can be classified into different states. Pupils will learn about how gases move and that materials change state when they are heated or cooled. They will learn about evaporation, and how water moves in a cycle.

RE

How can religion make a difference in people's lives? Pupils will learn about the meaning of faith and belief and that faith and/or belief can affect people's actions. They will explore what having a religious faith means to believers.

Art/DT

Take a Seat: Pupils will discuss what chairs tell us about everyday life and the way people rest, eat and relate to each other. They will explore designs in the past and in other cultures as inspiration for developing their own designs.

Music

Exploring musical processes: Pupils will develop an understanding of the process of composing by creating and performing music in response to musical and non-musical stimuli.

Geography

Water: Pupils will learn the three states of matter. They will learn the key aspects of the water cycle and how clouds and rain are formed. Pupils will learn how and why drinking water is cleaned. They will learn the causes and effects of flooding, and causes and effects of water pollution.

PSHE

Safety in the community/Respecting Privacy: Pupils will develop an awareness of the need to feel safe and will be able to recognise an unsafe environment. Pupils will be able to recognise a need for privacy and respect the privacy of others.

Relationship Education

the Lifecycles: Pupils will learn the key facts about lifecycles for humans and animals.

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Computing

We are publishers: Pupil will explore different illustrated books, and learn how they are used. Pupils will learn how to create a piece of digital art, and will recreate their own version of an illustrated book.
